8. DISASTER TRAINING and EXERCISES

Being prepared to respond and recover from a disaster requires that those who are responsible for planning and managing emergency operations be adequately trained and, to the greatest extent possible, experienced through participation in practical OHCC Disaster Exercises.

Disaster Training

Specialized Training Courses will be provided to participants free of charge using FEMA's Emergency Management Institute (EMI), Independent Study program, administered in one of two ways:

- 1. Through individually paced direct internet access, or
- 2. Downloading the training material and conducting the study in a classroom environment

Upon satisfactory completion, a Certificate will be issued.
