



Neighbor Helping Neighbor (NHN)

Our Purpose:

- **Focus** on identifying what types of services may be needed to assist OHCC residents during daily living as well as to help alleviate the impact of disasters on the OHCC community
- **Create** a plan reaching out to the OHCC community to ensure that all residents are aware of NHN and the assistance that NHN can provide
- Ensure that trained volunteers are always available for continuity of the NHN programs
- Publicize program successes and share those with the OHCC community for celebration and honoring volunteers



Neighbor Helping Neighbor

Establish a Neighborhood Plan:

- **Help and support** the OHCC community during daily living and during an incident and/or disaster.
- Coordinate efforts to reach out to each OHCC household:
 - o Distribute and explain the "OK/HELP" Sign and the "Vial of Life".
 - Create a list of those who may need help in an emergency (e.g. loss of power, fire, earthquake)
 - Develop a list of those who are frail, homebound or have disabilities, who may welcome help from time—to-time.
 - o **Determine** if someone in the household would be capable of assisting others.

Establish a Neighborhood Plan:

- Coordinate efforts with the SERT Club Board to attend OHCC Village Board meetings (8
 Villages) explaining our mission and, if permitted, posting SERT information in the individual village newsletters.
- **Connect** with the RV Club and other OHCC social clubs to introduce the NHN team and the SERT Club and seek symbiotic relationships.
- Work with the Public Safety Committee to engage OHCC residents to attend public safety, training and development events, and partner with the First Aid Team & Public Safety Committee in ongoing training programs.

Neighbor Helping Neighbor

Establish a Neighborhood Plan:

- Seek and contact SERT Club Members and OHCC residents who have medical backgrounds and/or emergency technical skills (i.e. law enforcement, fire fighters, social workers) that may be necessary in an incident or natural disaster.
- **Perform random acts of kindness** by bringing cookies or a meal, taking a neighbor to a medical appointment, getting groceries, visiting someone who is alone or help with a pet.
- Encourage OHCC residents to communicate with the NHN Team by publishing a
 Questionnaire in <u>OHCC Living</u> and/or <u>The Village Voice</u>.
