#### SAFETY COORDINATORS PROGRAM

Safety Coordinators (SCs) assist their neighbors in preparing for an emergency. They share safety tips and help neighbors get to know one another. One thing we have found is that streets with a Safety Coordinator had a much higher level of preparedness during our recent Earthquake Safety Drill. These streets had 80%+ of the houses with OK/Help signs displayed. Many SCs went door-to-door reminding their neighbors of the Earthquake Drill and encouraging them to review their emergency supplies.
